

The **Integration and Migration Service Centre (FIM)** offers refugees as well as those with or without migratory backgrounds guidance in regards to integration specific questions or inquiries.

We are a strongly connected network of locations and service centres displaying experience gained over decades of Migration and Integration work, with the dedication of employees and volunteers with expertise in many languages.

Integration Agency

The needs of migrants who have been living for a longer period of time in Germany are the focus of the work done by the Integration Agency. A respectful approach and exchange among people with different ethnic and cultural backgrounds, equality between men and women in social, religious and educational realms, create the basis for the programs that we offer in these areas:

- Civil Engagement
- Intercultural Awareness
- Socially-Oriented Integration Work
- Anti-Discrimination Work

Integration Counselling

The Integration and Migration Service Centre offers region-wide free and multi-lingual counselling opportunities. The offer for counselling encompasses adults with migratory backgrounds, irrelevant of land of origin, religion or status. We offer services divided into the following focal points:

- Refugee Counselling
- MBE – Migration Counselling for Adult Migrants - for those who have resided 3 years or less in Germany
- Counselling for Longer-Term Migrants of Germany - for those who have resided more than 3 years in Germany

Integration Courses

Language is not only a medium for daily communication, but rather a resource for expanding or diminishing one's chances in the apprenticeship or employment markets. With this in mind, the nurturing of language development is our main area of concern which we approach using special social pedagogical methods. The current language opportunities include:

- Integration Course
- Orientation Course
- German Language Groups for Refugees and Migrants

Integration Projects
